### February is the Last Opportunity for Students to Get Feedback on Their TOK and EE

*This is a reminder to submit your TOK and EEs!*

The TOK and Extended Essays are two components of the IB program that a number of students find extremely difficult. The distinctive structure of the TOK essay is the primary reason for this. However, it is possible to do it correctly if you use appropriate examples and have sufficient knowledge.

The most concerning factor for the students is the TOK and extended essay deadlines. Students struggle to meet deadlines when they have so much on their plates. However, the deadlines must be met. If you plan properly, **YOU CAN DO IT!**

Students must contact their IB schools to submit their TOK essays because schools traditionally set internal deadlines. Schools typically utilize an internal process to determine these dates. For most institutions, the deadlines are in February or March.

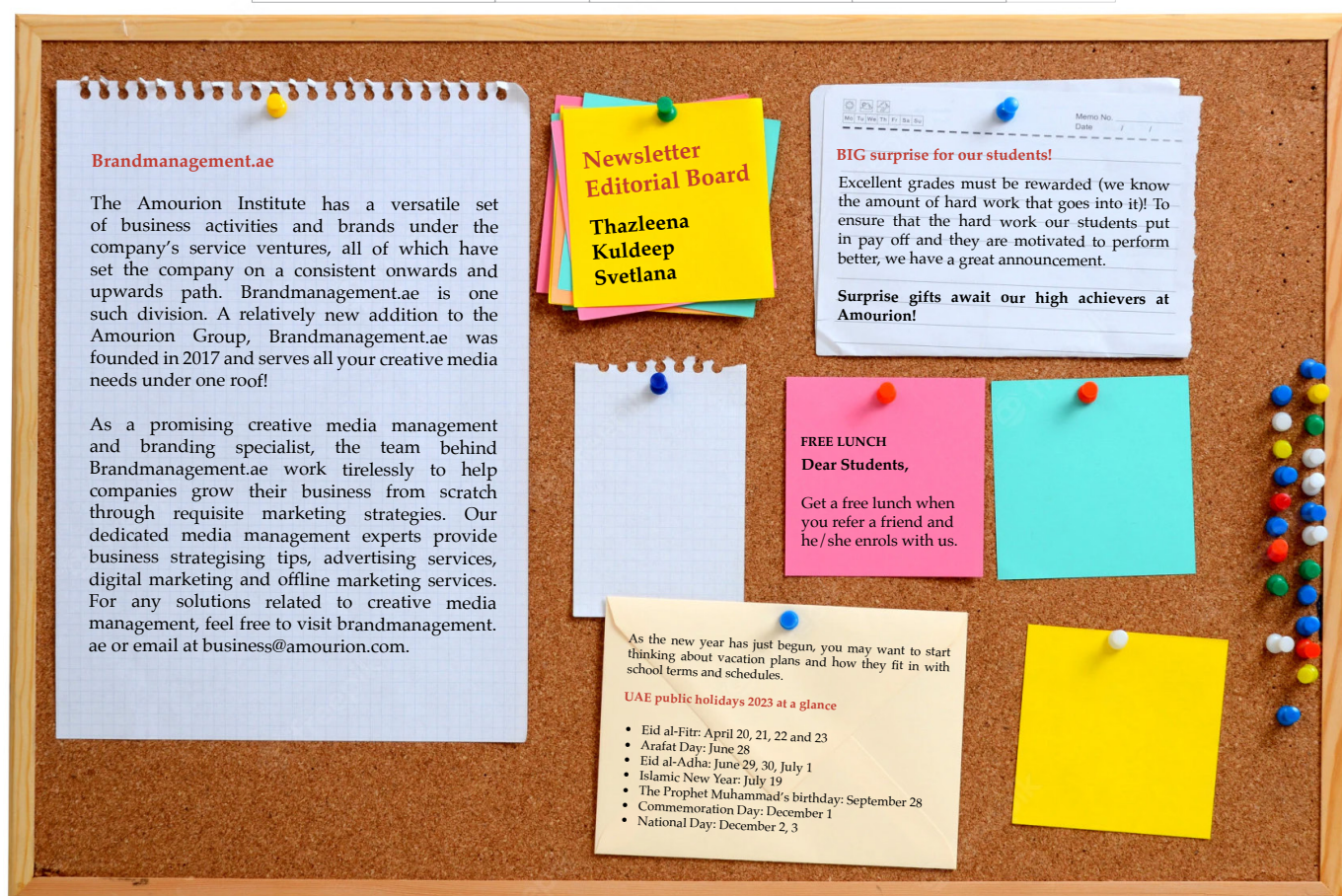


## Amourion Group Spreads its Wings Further
