#### 9. What words of wisdom would you like to give our readers?

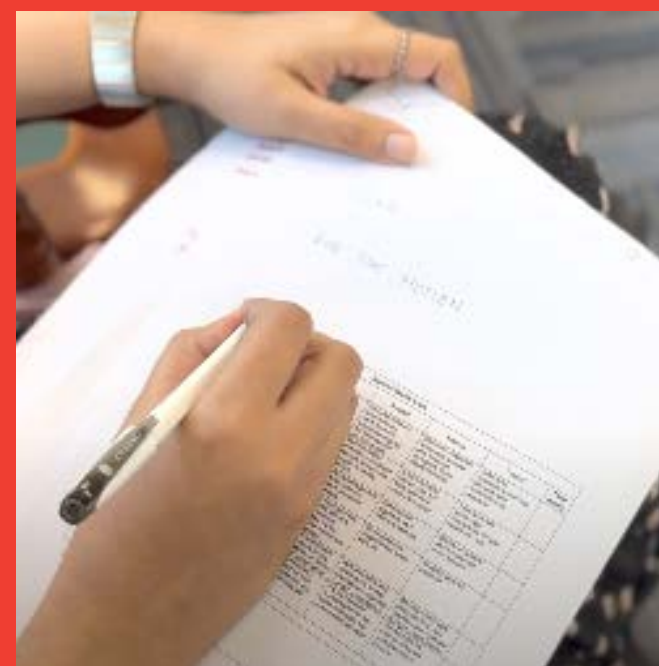
Teach the youth and new generations not only technology but also the right character to use this technology for the betterment of their own lives and of the country.

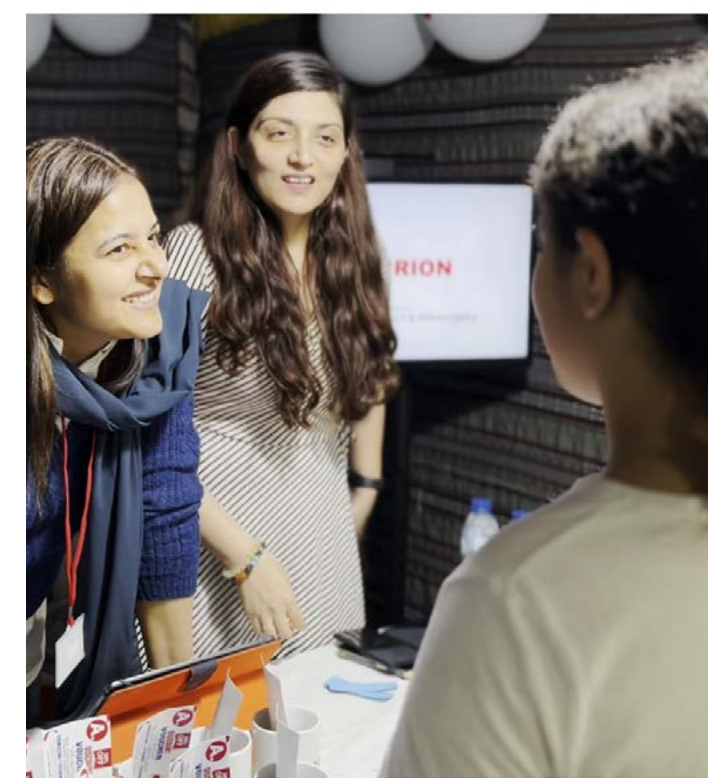


# The Winter Carnival Experience!
